The Electric Vehicle Homecharge Scheme is a government-funded scheme to support the roll-out of home charging equipment for plug-in vehicles at domestic properties.

The installing electrician should complete an electrical installation certificate, a copy of which should be given to the primary vehicle user and a copy kept for the Installers records.

The installing electrician should take two good quality photographs of the unit once installed one should be a close up clearly showing the serial number of the chargepoint in situ, and one should be a long shot showing the charger installed in an appropriate location with off road parking (e.g. in a garage or on the wall of the house, showing the parking area as well).
